

# Celebration Photo Frame - Steps

## Supplies

### At Testors

Testors Craft Paint – 297525 Gold Rush, 297508 Chalkboard

### Miscellaneous

Americana Gloss Enamels Stick-On Stencil

Art Minds Photo Frame 12” square

Small and medium foam brushes

Fine paintbrush

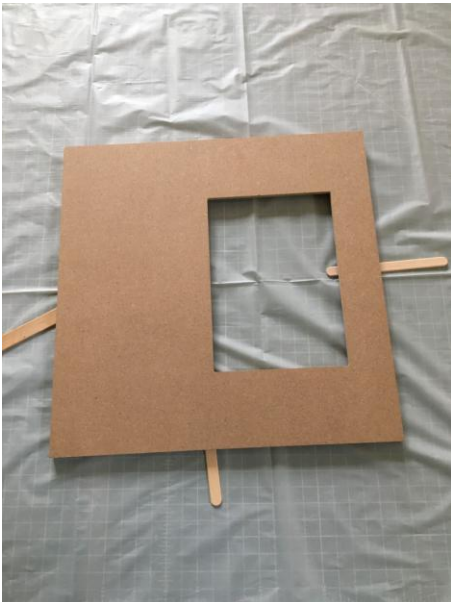
Small disposable container

Craft sticks

Chalk Marker

Photo frame measures 12” square and holds a 5” x 7” photo

1. Remove the back of the frame and the glass. Clean the glass of dust and fingerprints. Set it aside. Wipe off the front of the frame with a lint free cloth. Set craft sticks under the frame to make it easy to handle if you should need to turn it. Protect your work surface with plastic.



2. Add chalk paint to a small container. Use a medium foam brush to apply the paint with even strokes to the frame. Allow the paint to dry. Apply two more coats.



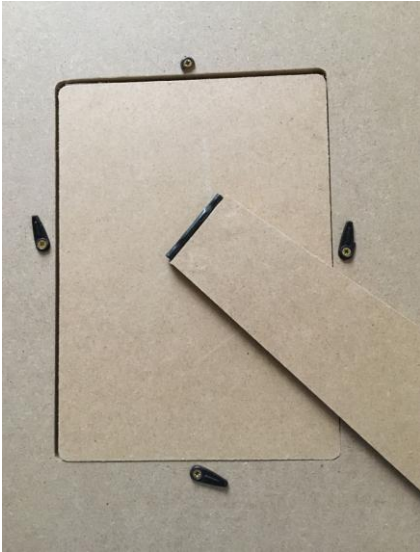
3. Center the stencil in the top left half of the frame. Cover surrounding areas to avoid getting paint on them. Use a small foam brush to daub glitter paint into the open areas of the stencil. Allow the paint to dry.



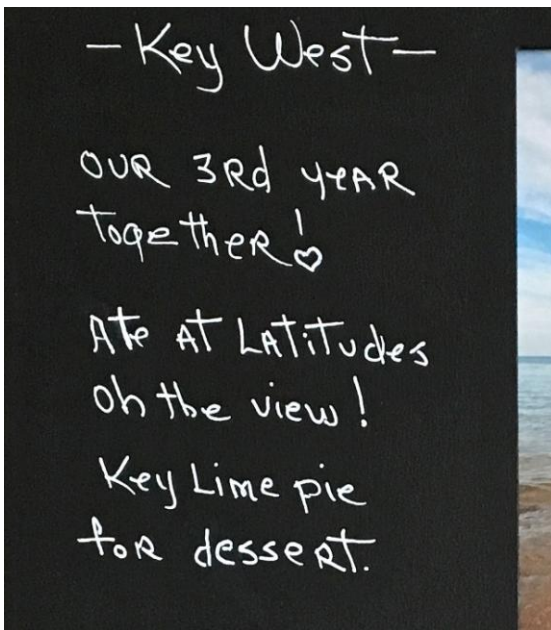
4. Remove the stencil. Use a fine paintbrush to fill in spotty areas in the lettering.



- Return the glass to the frame. Add a special photo and replace the frame backing.



- Use a chalk marker to write special memories about the day the photo was taken, on the frame. The frame can be reused with different memories and photos for any occasion.
